Online ID Card Renewal

Sponsors can renew eligible dependent ID cards online and have the new card mailed to them directly!

- Dependent must already be enrolled in DEERS
- Sponsor cannot replace their own ID Card (just the dependents)
- Dependents 17 years and under need a photo less than 12 years old in DEERS
- Dependents 18 years and over two forms of ID and photo less than 12 years old in DEERS

Instructions:

Sponsors follow the below instructions to order their dependent's ID Card:

- Search https://idco.dmdc.osd.mil/idco/ (or scan QR code)
- Select the "Family ID Cards" hyperlink
- Select DS login or CAC
- Enter your information
- Select "Request New ID" next to the desired dependent
 - System will notify you if you meet new requirements
 - If approved, DMDC will process and mail the ID to the address on file in DEERS (two week turn around)
 - The local ID card office <u>IS NOT</u> involved in this process at all
 - Please do not request a dependent's ID at an ID Card office if you began this process online



How do I navigate JBSA childcare options?

MilitaryChildCare.com (MCC) is a Department of Defense website for military families seeking child care. This site will allow families to search for and request care from a wide range of military operated and military subsidized child care options across all Services to include Child Development Centers, School Age Programs, and Family Child Care Homes. Additional benefits from Child and Youth Programs (CYP) are standardized procedures for effective waiting list management, expedited placement of children and youth into available programs, and enhanced daily operations for MilitaryChildCare.com (MCC)

JBSA CDCs:

FCC serves as waitlist mitigation and alternative hours care options. Currently 11 FCC homes supporting 56 Children.

JBSA Youth Programs Partnership Initiatives:

Pre-K For SA:

Developing MOU to formalize partnership to expand availability of offinstallation community childcare.

AFSVC and HAF/A1S coordination required.

Brighton Center:

Developing MOU to allow expedited, direct placement at Brighton Center for children with special needs seeking childcare through support of the Inclusion Action Team (IAT) process and panel decision.

Kids Included Together (KIT):

DAF Pilot Program provides quarterly inclusion training through KIT Academy.

Family Child Care (FCC):

- \$100 per week for each family household member younger than 2, \$75 for ages 2-7
- Become Provider \$300
- Enroll from waitlist one-time \$200
- Recruit new provider \$500 after certified for 90 days
- Receive \$1000 for initial accreditation,
 \$750 re-acc through NAFCC


