This Red Cross class is for people interested in being certified as a lifeguard and for employment as a GS-2 lifeguard for the summer of 2024. Participants must be 15 or older to sign up for the course. Participants must:

1. Swim 300 yards continuously, demonstrating breath control and rhythmic breathing. Candidates may swim using the front crawl, breaststroke or a combination of both but swimming on the back or side is not allowed. Swim goggles allowed.
2. Tread water for two minutes without using their hands.
3. Complete a timed event within one minute and 40 seconds. Swim goggles are not allowed.
 - Starting in the water, swim 20 yards.
 - Then surface dive 7-10 feet and retrieve a 10-pound object.
 - Next, swim 20 yards back to start point holding the 10-pound object with face at or near the surface.

Online ID Card Renewal

Sponsors can renew eligible dependent ID cards online and have the new card mailed to them directly!

- Dependent must already be enrolled in DEERS
- Sponsor cannot replace their own ID Card (just the dependents)
- Dependents **17 years** and under need a **photo less than 12 years old** in DEERS
- Dependents **18 years** and over **two forms of ID** and **photo less than 12 years old** in DEERS

Instructions:

Sponsors follow the below instructions to order their dependent's ID Card:

- Search <https://idco.dmdc.osd.mil/idco/> (or scan QR code)
- Select the "Family ID Cards" hyperlink
- Select DS login or CAC
- Enter your information
- Select "Request New ID" next to the desired dependent
 - System will notify you if you meet new requirements
 - If approved, DMDC will process and mail the ID to the address on file in DEERS (two week turn around)
 - The local ID card office **IS NOT** involved in this process at all
 - Please do not request a dependent's ID at an ID Card office if you began this process online

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Shipping Household Goods This Summer?

#1. CREATE A SHIPMENT REQUEST

Upon receipt of orders, visit DPS website to create shipment request. Access link at <https://www.militaryonesource.mil/movingpcs/movingpersonalproperty/>

Request dates at least 3 weeks in advance and provide a 7 day spread window for scheduling a pick-up date. In addition to a government move, you may create another request a Personally Procured Move (PPM).

#2. SCHEDULE A BRIEFING

Call local PPPO to schedule for a MANDATORY briefing. For JBSA LAK, call or sign-up using our link <https://teamup.com/Rsffq2p8zqwa94yal>

Out-processing personal property briefing is held every Tuesdays & Thursdays at 0900.



#3. PREPARE YOUR HOME/ BELONGINGS

Tidy up your residence; remove items from the walls; disconnect washer/dryer; disassemble and clean outdoor and gym equipment. (The carrier can refuse service for unsanitary or not accessible). Create your own inventory and obtain appraisals for antiques.

#4. VERIFY YOUR INVENTORY

Confirm all items are accounted for and the condition is annotated. Include pro-gear and gun safes, during pickup and delivery. Note any inaccuracies before signing.

#5. CHECK FOR DAMAGES/MISSING ITEMS

Report any damage to your residence to the pick-up/delivery servicing agent. You have 180 days to notify your moving company about lost or damaged items. Visit DPS to submit a claim for reimbursement.

#6. COMPLETE THE CUSTOMER SATISFACTION SURVEY

CSS will be sent out via email and text message to obtain your feedback to make future moves better for military families. Please complete within 7 days after delivery.

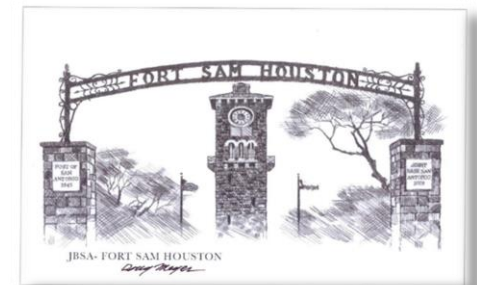

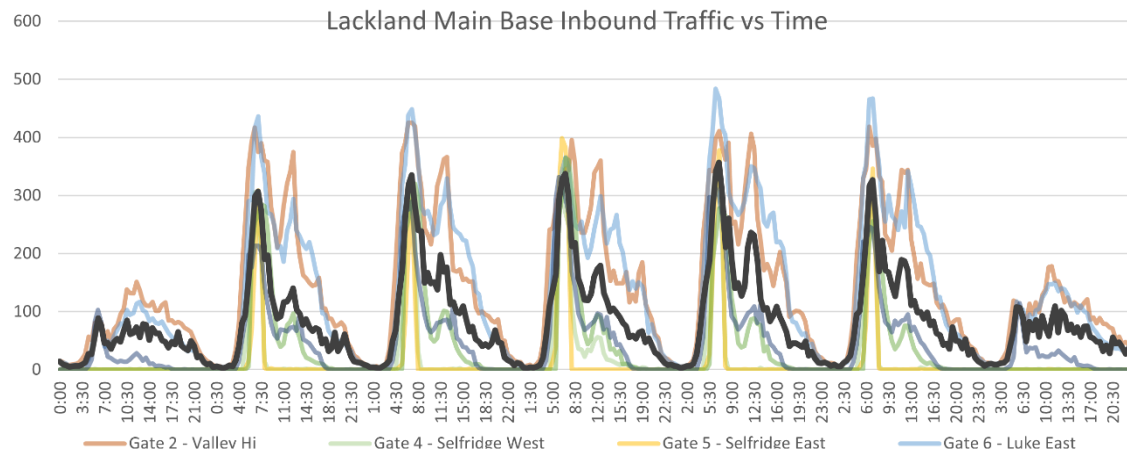

- Graduation is a **12%** increase (**~3000 vehicles**)
 - Visitors slow traffic and increase traffic by **5%**; Valley Hi **4% (14)** & Luke East **8% (15)**
- IACP Changes in hours & access privileges
 - Reduced traffic wait and queuing by **30 to 40 minutes**
 - Whole of squadron approach (Staff, Early Reporting, Data Collection)
 - Reduced average turn arounds **5%** = time savings of 3 min per vehicle
