SUBJECT: Fire Protection and Prevention Guidance

- 1. Effective 1 October 2013, Joint Base San Antonio (JBSA) facility managers will utilize Air Force Instruction 91-203, *Air Force Consolidated Occupational Safety Instruction*, 15 June 2012, for fire protection and prevention guidance. AFI 91-203 will supersede all fire protection and prevention guidance from JBSA-Lackland, JBSA-Randolph, and JBSA-Fort Sam Houston.
- 2. AFI 91-203 is a comprehensive instruction that encompasses fire protection and prevention guidance. This document updates and merges Air Force safety principles, concepts and program elements into a single consolidated occupational safety and health document. Chapter 6 specifically addresses fire protection and prevention. Subsequent chapters provide guidance on housekeeping, electrical safety, flammable & combustible storage, welding safety, and other relevant fire safety issues.
- 3. JBSA Fire Emergency Service is committed to providing first class customer service to complete this transition. Our goal is to establish your fire protection and prevention guidance for a safer JBSA community. If there are questions regarding this matter, please contact your local fire prevention office.
