## Tax Season

As military members, we come to expect frequent changes and surprises, but don't get taken by surprise on 15 April 2016 by the individual income tax return filing deadline. Filing your tax return does not have to be stressful, and there are many services available – some of them free – that make filing quite easy. Online programs are a popular and inexpensive way to electronically file your tax return. Military OneSource (MilitaryOneSource.mil) provides access to free tax preparation software with on-call assistance from tax professionals. This is available to active duty members, as well as Guard/Reserve members and dependents. You may also hire a private company to complete your taxes.

In addition to the options above, during tax season this year, the JA teams at JBSA-Fort Sam Houston, JBSA-Lackland, and JBSA-Randolph will each operate a tax center for active duty service members and retirees. The tax centers will operate from February through mid-April. The tax centers provide free tax preparation, electronic filing, and tax form distribution for federal and state tax returns.

To receive assistance at the JBSA Tax Centers you must bring with you your <u>Form W-2</u>, Wage and Tax Statement, and your <u>Form 1095</u>, required under the Affordable Care Act. These documents are available to through myPay. Also bring your <u>Social Security card</u> and the Social Security card of each individual you intend to claim as a dependent. If applicable to your financial situation, you must also bring the following:

December 2015 Leave and Earnings Statement

1099-INT or 1099-DIV to report any interest or dividends you received as income in 2015 1098 to report payment of mortgage interest and property taxes, if any 1099-B for stock sales in 2015 together with your cost basis for capital gain or loss calculations 1099-R to report any distributions from an IRA or 401k you've received in 2015 SSA-1099 to report any Social Security benefits received in 2015 If you've already received a 2015 state tax refund, you may need to report it as income. 1099-MISC if you have self-employment or miscellaneous income, outside of your regular job

Have your documents with you, otherwise your tax preparer will not be able to help you. Tax center personnel will review your documents and help you complete your tax return.
