SUBJECT: JBSA#46, Environmental, Safety, Occupational Health (ESOH) Risk Management

1. In accordance with AFI 91-202, *United States Air Force Mishap Prevention Program*, dated 5 August 2011, paragraph 1.5.14.13, commanders are required to publish guidance on safety and occupational health expectations. Commanders are the unit's "Chief of Safety" and ensure Environmental, Safety, Occupational Health (ESOH), and Risk Management attitudes are pervasive within the unit. Supervisors are the direct link between commanders and workers, and must ensure people are properly trained, have realistic ESOH attitudes and enforce standards. Each must understand and comply with the standards as well as know their personal limits.
2. Our daily training and execution efforts involve a necessary level of risk that we assume for an important benefit...mission accomplishment. Uncontrolled hazards and unsafe acts represent unnecessary risk to our team and our mission. However, our duty is to execute the mission and avoid mishaps. Properly managing risks, holding each other accountable, and promptly reporting hazards will not only keep us safe, but will also ensure we properly execute the mission of the installation.
3. As the installation commander, I am responsible for the well being of all 502 ABW personnel. Our goal is ZERO fatalities and ZERO Class A mishaps. In order to safely provide the combat service and support capability our mission partners depend on, I need each of you to be a leader in our ESOH programs by thinking readiness and applying risk management in every aspect of your jobs and your lives. Your risk management decisions today will determine how successful our missions are tomorrow!
