Chief Master Sergeant David A. Brown is the Command Chief Master Sergeant, 19th Air Force, Joint Base San Antonio- Randolph, Texas. The 19th Air Force trains more than 30,000 U.S. and allied students annually. The training ranges from introductory flying training, undergraduate flying training through advanced combat crew training, and ultimately provides fully qualified aircrew personnel to the warfighting commands. The 19th Air Force is composed of more than 30,000 Total Force personnel and 1,350 aircraft assigned to 16 bases located across the United States. Chief Brown is a key advisor to the 19th Air Force commanders and senior staff on all matters affecting training, education, readiness, and effective utilization of resources in the execution of the 19th Air Force mission.



Chief Brown entered the Air Force in February 1989. He graduated from the Public Health Technician Course at Brooks Air Force Base, Texas, in June 1989. His background includes public health duties at various units stateside and deployments in support of Operations Desert Storm, Desert Focus and Southern Watch. Throughout his career he has filled a myriad of roles, such as, Airman Leadership School Instructor and Commandant at the ALS and NCOA level. Chief Brown has also served as a First Sergeant at stateside and overseas locations within three different major commands.

Prior to assuming his current position, he served as the Command Chief, 366th Fighter Wing, Mountain Home AFB, Idaho.
