## MEMORANDUM FOR ALL SUBORDINATE COMMANDS AND JBSA TENANT UNITS

## SUBJECT: JBSA COVID-19 Guidance Memorandum #64 – Implementation HPCON BRAVO PLUS, Categorical Exceptions to Guidance on Use of Masks and Isolation/Quarantine Protocols

- 1. The local incidence rate for COVID-19 has increased significantly in the last 8 days and will likely continue to increase in the coming weeks. To better protect our JBSA community while preserving our ability to perform our vital missions, I am changing the Health Protection Condition (HPCON) from BRAVO to BRAVO PLUS effective 0001 hours 6 January 2022.
- 2. The key measures implemented with this transition to HPCON BRAVO PLUS include:
  - Leaders should maintain less than 40 percent of normal occupancy in the workplace
  - Limit indoor social gatherings NOTE: Commander's Calls and official functions to include promotion and retirement ceremonies are considered official gatherings, not social events
  - Limit in-person meeting attendance as applicable
  - Be prepared to limit access or cancel events or exercises
  - Military commanders may restrict off-duty military personnel from off-installation venues
  - Wear your mask properly (covering the nose and mouth), enforce physical distance standards, and maintain good personal and workplace hygiene practices at all times
