MEMORANDUM FOR ALL SUBORDINATE COMMANDS AND JBSA TENANT UNIT

SUBJECT: JBSA COVID-19 Guidance Memorandum (GM) #67 Implementation of HPCON Alpha and Modified Mask Guidance.

1. Joint Base San Antonio (JBSA) will transition to Health Protection Condition (HPCON) ALPHA, effective 1 April 2022 at 0001 based on minimal community transmission.

2. IAW Attachment 1, Under Secretary of Defense Memorandum dated 1 Mar 22, Attachment 2 Safer Federal Workforce Task Force Guidance dated 28 Feb 22, and due to Bexar county being at CDC COVID-19 community level classification – "Low":

- a) Mask wear is optional regardless of vaccination status. Except:
 - (1) Accessing health and dental facilities or on-base transportation.
 - (2) If directed by your immediate Commander due to health and safety concerns in the workplace.
 - (3) DoD force health protection guidance for workplace access and mask wear for personnel with symptoms, a positive test, or exposure to persons with COVID-19 remain in effect
- b) COVID-19 screening testing program is no longer required for DoD personnel

3. There are no workplace occupancy restrictions unless directed by your Commander. All should adhere to the most current DoD and CDC guidance to assess the workplace risk.
