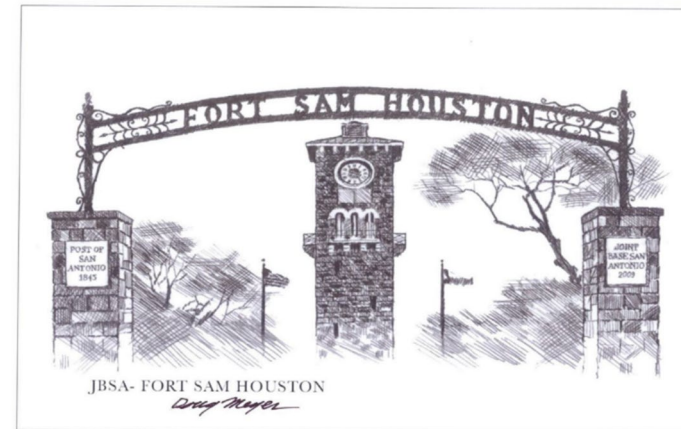

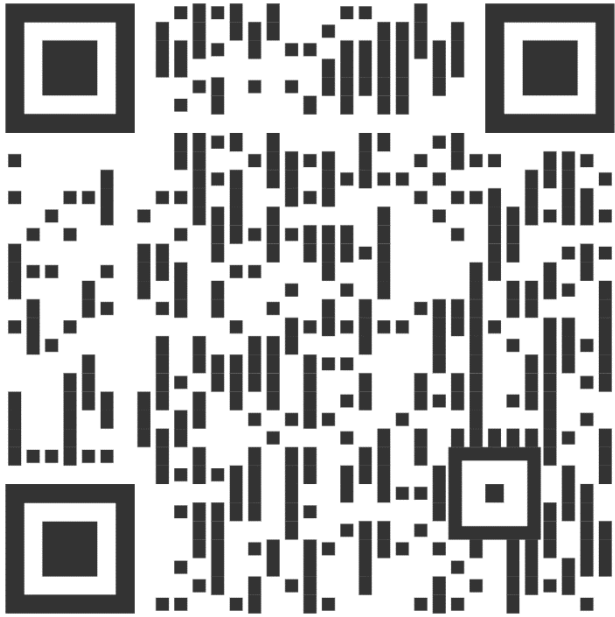

## Do you need Before and After School Care?

- Visit **MilitaryChildCare.com**
- Request Before and After School Care
  - Ages 5-12 years old for your specific installation.
  - **Fees:** Weekly child care based on total family income.
  - **Priority:** Based on your sponsor type  
(Active Duty Military, Single Military, DoD Civilian, etc.)
- Child & Youth Program Business Management System (**CYPBMS**)-
  - New system to electronically enroll children in child care once a child care spots has been offered. Website: <https://parent.afcyp.com>
- Age appropriate and developmental appropriate activities cover:
  - life skills, animal care, cooking, homework help, science, arts and crafts, physical fitness, dramatic play, STEM, technology, and leadership.
- JBSA School-Age Care Program:
  - **Highly accreditation standard** with the Council on Accreditation (COA)
    - Receives Annual Unannounced Air Force HQ inspection to ensure all local inspections are compliance ie.  
(Fire, safety, health interactions, curriculum standards, and community service projects, etc.)

# School-Age Care Program

**Volunteer Opportunities:** Not just for coaches, YP is looking for adult and teen volunteers for every area of scheduled activities. Adult volunteers: mentors to facilitate coding, robotics, art, music, and community events. Upcoming community events: Haunted Trail, Oktoberfest, and holiday parade. Teens and youth, check with YP for all the opportunities to earn volunteer hours. Record keeping is maintained at YP to support performance ratings, scholarships, or for other personal requirements.



**CYP Keyless Controlled Access Entry:** All CYP primary doors are now locked for entry. Doors are always unlocked for exit. Parents of YP active membership, please bring your issued CAC to code and gain entry to the facilities. If a parent/guardian does not have a CAC, a fob will be issued. YP youth membership will be offered a fob for entry while their membership is active. Fob is issued to the person, entry of who entered and fob ID will be verified at each entry. NOTE: access system is stand alone, if a family has children enrolled in CDC, SAC, and YP; CAC or fob will have to be activated at each facility.



# Online ID Card Renewal

## Purpose:

- DMDC has initiated a **Pilot program** for an Online ID Card Renewal Process, **effective immediately**
- Sponsors can renew their eligible dependent's ID card online and have the new card mailed directly to them without ever visiting an ID card office!
  - The dependent must have already been enrolled in DEERS
  - Sponsor cannot replace their own ID Card (just the dependents)
  - Dependents 17 yrs old and under need a photo less than 12 years old in DEERS
  - Dependents 18 yrs old and over need two forms of ID, must already be in DEERS, and also need a photo under that's less than 12 years old

## Instructions:

- Sponsors can follow the below instructions to order their dependent's ID Card:
  - Search <https://idco.dmdc.osd.mil/idco/>
  - Select the "Family ID Cards" hyperlink
  - Select DS login or CAC
  - Enter your information
  - Select "Request New ID" next to the desired dependent
    - System will notify you if you meet new requirements
    - If approved, DMDC will process and mail the ID to the address on file in DEERS (two week turn around)
      - Local ID card office is not involved in this process at all
    - Please do not request a dependent's ID at an ID Card office, if you already began this process online

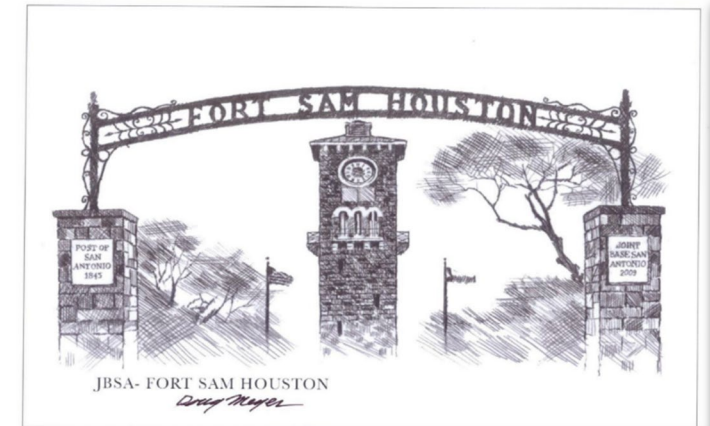

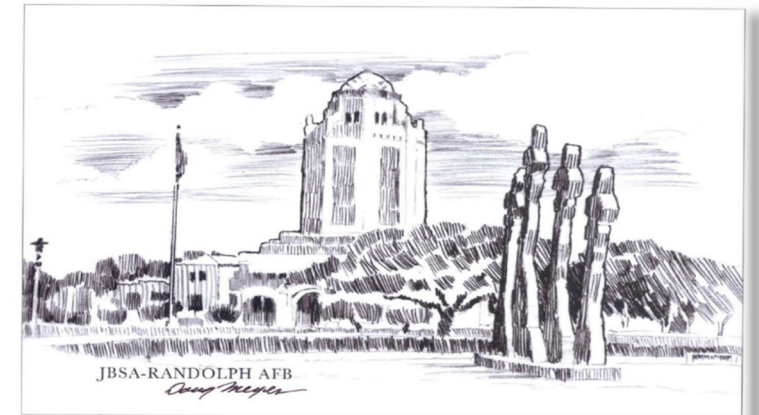

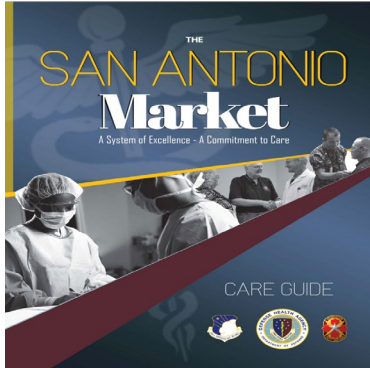
