SUBJECT: Patron Eligibility for JBSA Military Dining Facilities (DFACs)

1. In accordance with DAFMAN 34-131, *Appropriated Fund (APF) Food Service Program Management*, 10 October 2023, paragraph 2.2, at installations that have not converted to Food 2.0, the installation commander may authorize personnel to eat meals in the DFAC after determining other facilities, including nonappropriated fund (NAF) food activities, installation exchange cafeterias, and installation restaurants are not available, adequate, or readily accessible to the duty station and that sufficient capability to provide this meal service is available within the DFAC operation.
2. All enlisted personnel are authorized to utilize the DFACs within JBSA. As such, commanders and civilian leaders who are a part of a command team are herein authorized to consume meals to support their assigned Essential Station Messing (ESM) meal card holders personnel.
3. Other personnel authorized to use the DFACs:
 - a. All personnel with base access are authorized to dine at the Wingman Café Food 2.0 (Randolph)
 - b. Institutional Training Directed Lodging & Meals (ITDLM) students
 - c. First Responders (Military and civilians)
 - d. Chaplains, when ministering to personnel
 - e. Non-Medical Assistants (civilians assisting wounded warriors)
 - f. Permanent party officers/DoD civilians may dine at the Chapman Training Annex, Rocco (FSH) Camp Bullis (bldg. 5107)
 - g. Personnel (enlisted/officers) in PCS status and their family members may dine at the Rocco DFAC on JBSA-Ft Sam Houston (FSH) (Slagel when Rocco is closed)
 - h. Active-duty family members and military retirees and their family members may eat the traditional Thanksgiving/Christmas meals at designated JBSA DFACs
4. Please note the following exceptions:
 - a. All DFACs designated for Basic Military Training (BMT) at JBSA-Lackland are for use by Basic Military Trainees, their leadership and cadre ONLY
 - b. The Defender Inn (bldg. 5420) and Medical Readiness Training Facility (bldg. 6361) at Camp Bullis are for use by AF-sponsored trainees, their leadership and cadre ONLY

c. The Slagel DFAC at JBSA-FSH is for use by students, their leadership and cadre ONLY (with the exception noted in para 3e as well as permanent party ESM on weekends and holidays)
