The purpose of the FYR is to determine if the final remedies for these sites, which consist of land use controls to prevent residential use of the sites, are and will continue to be protective of human health and the environment. The remedies at these sites address soil and groundwater contamination consisting of metals, volatile organic compounds, and polyaromatic hydrocarbons. The review is required by DAFI32-7020_DAFGM2024-01, *Environmental Restoration Program*, to ensure the cleanup continues to protect human health and the environment.
