# Living with Wildlife on JBSA





The best way to keep wild animals in their natural habitat, and out of harm's way in the urban environment, is to reduce wildlife attractants.

# **Prevention:**

Garbage - dispose of properly and secure

Pet food - keep food & water for pets indoors.

BBQ grills - clean and stow after use

Remove vegetation near buildings, and all clutter, to reduce hiding places for animals.

## DO NOT FEED OR APPROACH WILDLIFE ON JBSA

Pest Management, Natural Resources and USDA APHIS Wildlife Services are the only personnel authorized to manage wildlife and feral animals on JBSA.

Tampering with wildlife management equipment such as traps or cameras is a punishable offense.
