SUBJECT: Fire Safety Campaign

- 1. The Joint Base San Antonio (JBSA) Fire Emergency Services organization has the responsibility to implement fire and life safety campaigns to address seasonal fire occurrences. The fire safety campaign objectives are to prepare personnel with the fire safety information necessary to prevent fires, intervene early when fire occurs and escape from fires.
- 2. JBSA Fire Prevention offices will use available media but not limited to the JBSA Fire Emergency Services webpage, newspapers, marquees and social media. Our target audience is military, civilians, contractors, military families and visitors. We will use guidance from the National Fire Protection Association and the United States Fire Administration.
