2. The above establishments were placed off-limits based on information obtained through the Joint Base San Antonio Armed Forces Disciplinary Control Board. The establishment of off-limits areas is a function of command used to help maintain good order and discipline, health, morale, safety, and welfare of personnel assigned and/or located at JBSA and/or in the Greater San Antonio area pursuant to the authority contained in the controlling Joint Instruction, *Armed Forces Disciplinary Control Boards and Off-Installation Liaison and Operations* (AR 190-24; OPNAVINST 1620.2A; AFI 31-213; MCO 1620.2D; COMDTINST 1620.1E), 27 July 2006.

3. As another resource, the Better Business Bureau (BBB) website at <http://www.bbb.org/> has ratings and reports for many businesses. Use of this website allows anyone to determine if a business has customer complaints or issues to consider before conducting any transactions.

4. This off-limits information should be briefed at forums such as newcomer's orientations and commander's calls, and should be posted on unit bulletin boards and other visible locations.
