COLONEL JEFFREY S. CAMERON

Colonel Jeffrey S. Cameron is the Deputy Commander of the 12th Flying Training Wing, Joint Base San Antonio-Randolph, Texas. The 12 FTW is the Source of America's Airpower, delivering unrivaled airpower leaders for the future of the U.S. Air Force. The wing consists of two flying groups and a maintenance group spanning more than 700 miles from Joint Base San Antonio, Texas to Naval Air Station Pensacola, Florida. The 12 FTW is responsible for five aviation training pipelines, Pilot Instructor Training, Undergraduate Combat Systems Officer Training, Undergraduate Remotely Piloted Aircraft pilot training, Career Enlisted Aviator training, and Fighter Bomber Fundamentals which prepares wingmen to transition into Fighter Training Units across the Air Force. Additionally, the wing oversees Electronic Warfare Training for the U.S. Joint Force and ally/partner nations from around the globe.

Colonel Cameron received his commission from the United States Air Force Academy in 2003. His career includes diverse operational, academic, and strategic assignments. He served at Wright-Patterson Air Force Base, Ohio, in program management and executive support roles; at Headquarters Pacific Air Forces, where he helped develop strategic frameworks for the Indo-Pacific region; and at the United States Naval War College as a Professor of Joint Military Operations. Colonel Cameron is a distinguished graduate of both the Air Command and Staff College and the United States Naval War College.



As a command pilot, Colonel Cameron accumulated 770 combat hours in the B-1B flown over Afghanistan, Iraq, and Syria. He commanded the 12th Operations Support Squadron at Joint Base San Antonio – Randolph, Texas, overseeing pilot instructor training, introduction to fighter fundamentals, and undergraduate remotely piloted aircraft training. Prior to his current position, Colonel Cameron was the Chief, Future Operations Division, Air Force Global Strike Command, Barksdale Air Force Base, Louisiana
