

# **COLONEL WILL B. FREDS**

COL Will Freds is the Deputy Commander of Joint Base San Antonio and the 502nd Air Base Wing. The 8,000person 502nd ABW consolidates 49 installation management support functions for a military community with an annual operating budget of more than \$700 million. The joint base supports more than 80,000 full-time personnel, 145,000 students and a retiree community of more than 250,000. The 502 ABW also supports more than \$37 billion in directed projects. The organization has host responsibilities for JBSA-Fort Sam Houston, JBSA-Camp Bullis, JBSA-Lackland, JBSA-Randolph, and seven other operating locations.

Freds graduated from the United States Military Academy at West Point with a degree in political science. Upon graduation, he was commissioned as a field artillery officer. Since then, he has held a variety of leadership positions for the U.S. Army. Freds completed multiple professional military training and advanced educational programs. Prior to his current position, the colonel was the chief of staff of U.S. Army North Task Force-51.

The colonel is a native of Northeast Indiana. He has a Master of Science degree in business administration from San Diego State University, a Master of Defense Studies



degree from the Canadian Forces College and a Master of Strategic Studies degree from the U.S. Army War College.

He has deployed twice to the Republic of Korea and completed one tour in Iraq in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom.
