Ms. De Los Santos is Executive Director for the 502d Force Support Group (FSG), Joint Base San Antonio, Texas, which includes JBSA-Randolph, JBSA-Lackland, JBSA-Fort Sam Houston and JBSA-Camp Bullis. The 3,000-person 502d FSG executes Force Support functions that bolster more than 266 mission partners, more than 80,000 full-time personnel and a local community of more than 250,000 retirees. Ms. De Los Santos oversees JBSA's Community Partnerships for Workforce and Transition.

Ms. De Los Santos is a Military Veteran/Retiree having served in the Air Force culminating with service in the Army as an Army Logistics Officer. She started her civil service career in 2004 as a Department of the Army Civilian serving as the Senior Logistics Officer for the 470th Military Intelligence Brigade, Fort Sam Houston, Texas. In 2008 she was the Plans Officer, then the Executive Officer for Fort Sam Houston Army Garrison working on the Joint Base San Antonio transformation and implementation. In October 2010, Ms. De Los Santos became a Department of the Air Force Civilian as part of the Joint Base-San Antonio transformation. She served as Deputy for Installation Support, 502d Mission Support Group, Joint Base-San Antonio, Fort Sam Houston. As of December 2013, Ms. De Los Santos serves as the Executive Director for the FSG. Ms. De Los Santos is a native of Brownsville, Texas.
