Lieutenant Colonel Rahsul J. Freeman is the Deputy Commander, 502d Force Support Group, Joint Base San Antonio (JBSA), Texas. He assists the commander in leading over 3,000 military, DoD civilian, and contractor personnel to provide force support services to JBSA in order to ensure the readiness and resiliency of all service members and their families. Additionally, the group supports the senior mission commander and mission partners as the JBSA Fort Sam Houston and Camp Bullis Executive Agent. Prior to his current position, Lt Col Freeman commanded a squadron of Military Training Instructors responsible for transforming 22% of all enlisted accessions into expeditionary, warrior-minded Airmen ready to deploy worldwide to 10 Major Commands. He also commanded the 20th Logistics Readiness Squadron at Shaw AFB, South Carolina at Air Combat Command's largest F-16 Fighter Wing.



Colonel Freeman received his commission in the Air Force on 16 August 2002 after graduating #1 in his Air Force Officer Training School class at Maxwell Air Force Base, Alabama. He is a Logistics Readiness Officer and has served in a variety of leadership roles at the squadron, group, wing and combatant command levels.
