COL Patrick J. Miller is the Deputy Commander of Joint Base San Antonio and the 502nd Air Base Wing. The 8,000- person 502nd ABW consolidates 49 installation management support functions for a military community with an annual operating budget of more than \$700 million. The joint base supports more than 80,000 full-time personnel, 145,000 students and a retiree community of more than 250,000. The 502 ABW also supports more than \$37 billion in directed projects. The organization has host responsibilities for JBSA-Fort Sam Houston, JBSA-Camp Bullis, JBSA-Lackland, JBSA-Randolph, and seven other operating locations.

COL Patrick J. Miller graduated from Texas State University and commissioned as a Military Intelligence Officer; branch detailed to Armor in 2000. He holds a Bachelor of Science degree, in Cartography and Geographical Information Systems, a Master of Human Relations from University of Oklahoma and a Master of Strategic Studies from the National War College.
