The JBSA-Randolph and Lackland Clubs, and the JBSA-Ft Sam Houston Community Center and Golf Course Club House will provide catered events by reservation only. All locations will remain in compliance with guidance on limiting capacity of facilities for gatherings, maintaining physical distancing, and utilizing enhanced sanitation precautions. This allows for various events to include, but not limited to Change-of-Commands/Leadership/Responsibility, promotion ceremonies, commander's calls, award ceremonies, retirement ceremonies, public affairs/community relations driven special events, official meetings and similar designated functions.
