JBSA Teammates,

This memo references JBSA COVID-19 Guidance Memo #9 dated 22 March 2020 which places a 14-day *Restriction of Movement (ROM)* order on service members returning to JBSA from locations within CONUS associated with a community at higher risk of acquiring COVID-19 infection.

In an effort to effectively support the flying training mission, permanent party aircrew members, performing flight duties, who returned to JBSA from any of the following states on or after 6 March 2020 are exempt from the 14-day ROM order. This ROM order still applies to all other permanent party:

- California
- Colorado
- Florida
- Georgia
- Illinois
- Louisiana
- Massachusetts
- New Jersey
- New York
- Pennsylvania
- Washington

Permanent party DoD civilian employees, contractor personnel, as well as family members are strongly encouraged to follow the ROM guidance as well in order to help prevent the spread of COVID-19. ROM involves remaining at home, monitoring temperature, and reporting development of symptoms of respiratory illness. The ROM starts on the day of departure from the state.
