COMMON TIP for Mold Prevention



Prep the battlefield and deny mold the chance to take hold! Maintaining common areas and personal living spaces is one of the best means to prevent mold growth. Clean kitchens, bathrooms and poorly ventilated areas by using a sponge/towel and one of the following:

- -For non-porous surfaces use warm soapy water or 1 cup of bleach per gallon of water.
- -For non-porous and porous surfaces use 3% hydrogen peroxide, vinegar or ¼ tablespoon baking soda & water.

 (DO NOT MIX CLEANING PRODUCTS TOGETHER AS IT COULD CREATE TOXIC VAPORS)



Unable to self-clean the affected area?

- First, contact facility manager or military training leader and allow maintenance to address the issue.
