




Strikes by Year




Strikes by Month


CY16 - CY20 by Month - All Aircraft

FY16 - FY20 by Month - All Aircraft






Strikes by Time

(Unknown strikes are typically discovered post-flight or on the runway)






Strikes by Aircraft Type

Aircraft Type






Strikes by Known Location
